This film is included in the “Nivelli Gesangs Serie” (Singing Series), produced by Max Nivelli between 1918-1922. In these films, music is the main theme and the storyline revolves around the way music influences people’s lives.

Shooting of the film ended in April 1919 and general information on the film appeared in the press. However, the censor gave its decision only in Aug. 1922, so it is assumed that it was then that the film was released to the theaters.
